

**Boating license** required? Not required in AZ to drive a boat. Of course the person who signs the Rental Contract and secures the damages must be a **legal adult** (age 18).

Do you need any **safety equipment**? We supply all the legally required equipment. By law children under the age of 12 have to be in a life vest the whole time they are aboard. We prefer they come into the office to be fit for the proper safe size. Any one on a jet ski or tube must wear a life vest at all times as well.

Open containers are allowed on the water but the laws for **drinking and driving** are the same as on land. The driver must be sober.

**Return times** vary somewhat with the time of year because of the time of sunset but all boats are to be off the water before sunset. The return time will be set before you leave the dock. If you are late in returning, the **late fee** is \$75 per hour per vessel (which is implemented in increments of 15 minutes).

Bring the dog: **No pets** allowed on the boats. Sorry, no exceptions.

Age limits? **All ages** will enjoy a day on the water but be wise to keep everyone hydrated and take a break from the sun under the Biminis (especially infants, elderly and fair skinned). If you have specific concerns, speak to their physician. Summer temps feel cooler on the water but it may still be 120+

What else is going on in Lake Havasu City while I'm there? Go to **golakehasvu.com** for great information.

Do I have to fill up before returning? You will leave with a full tank of **gas** and it will topped off when you return to the lot. You are charged for only the fuel you use. You have the option to fill up on the lake but it uses your boating time and the marinas are typically more expensive than we are.

How many people allowed? The **boat capacity** is set by law and is posted on every boat. This is strictly enforced on the water.

Want a day of music? The boats are equipped with radios but if **music** is a priority in your day, you may be more pleased with bringing along your own **system**. Remember to consider the battery charge in your plans for "rocking" all day.

What to expect the **day of your rental**: The paperwork will be completed which includes the contract (with rental fees), safety orientation, damage issues, and reviewing the map of the lake/river. Life vests are fitted if necessary. A video will be taken with you and the vessel before your leave and a second video will be taken upon return so as to document the condition vessel before and after the rental time. This

protects everyone. The drivers will be walked through the vessel to be sure everyone feels familiar with it. Your party will be loaded into our vans (autos left here avoid parking fees at the launch) along with your gear and food. It will take approximately 30-40 minutes from the time you arrive in the office until you will head for the water. The launch is less than 2 miles away. We will launch the boat. You take it from the dock, where we'll meet again at the designated time. We will remove the boat from the water and return you to the office.

What **supplies** should I bring? Water, sunglasses, hats, sunscreen, lip balm, water shoes, cover up and the food/beverages you wish to have for the day.

**Damage deposit** is covered by the credit card you leave on file while out on the lake. Charges are not made to that card unless damages are incurred during the rental. This is documented by the videos taken before departure and after your return.
